


Welcome to St. Helen's Catholic Infant School

Our mission statement is, "With Jesus alive in our hearts, we celebrate each other and learn together as a family."






Early Years Provision: Outstanding

Over Subscription Criteria 2025-2026

Over Subscription Criteria

Where the number of applications for admission <u>exceeds</u> the number of places available, the following criteria will be applied in order of priority set out below:

- Baptised Catholic looked after and previously looked after children. Highest priority is given to looked after children, Previously Looked after Children and those children who appear (to the admission authority) to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted. (see Notes 2&3)
- Baptised Catholic children who are resident in the parishes of Brentwood Cathedral Church of St. Mary & St. Helen with Holy Cross and All Saints, <u>Ingatestone</u> – St. John the Evangelist & St. <u>Erconwold</u> and Ongar – St. Helen Ongar and St. Margaret of Scotland <u>Doddinghurst</u>. (see Note 3)
- 3. Other Baptised Catholic children from other Parishes.(see Note 3)
- Other looked after and previously looked after children. (see Note 2)
- 5. Catechumens and members of the Eastern Christian Churches.(see Notes 5&6)
- Children who have a brother or sister attending at St. Helen's Catholic Infant or Junior School Academy at the time of admission and who do not fit into any of the categories above. (see Note 7)
- Children of other Christian denominations whose membership is evidenced by a minister of their religion. (see Note 8)
- 8. Children of other faiths whose membership is evidenced by a religious leader of their faith. (see Note 9)
- Any other children.
