

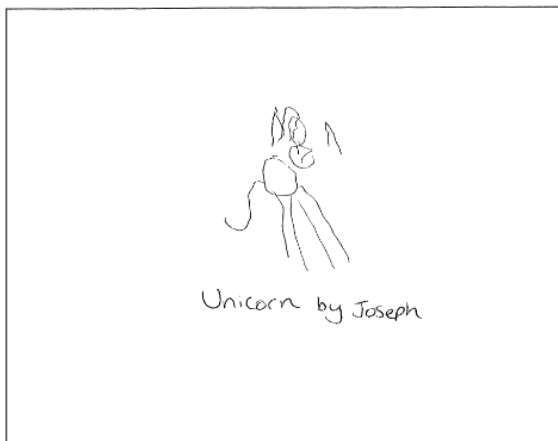

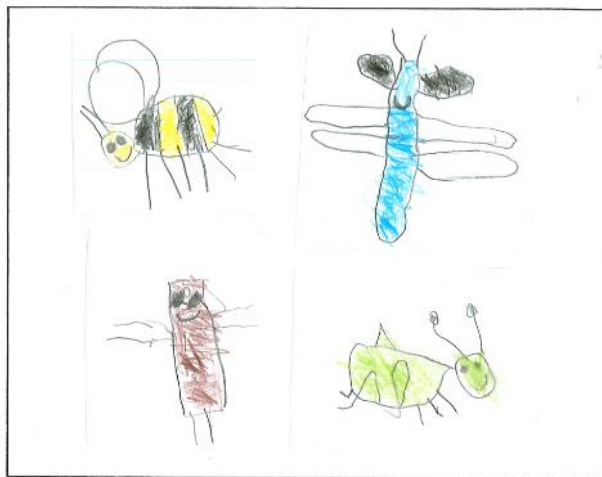

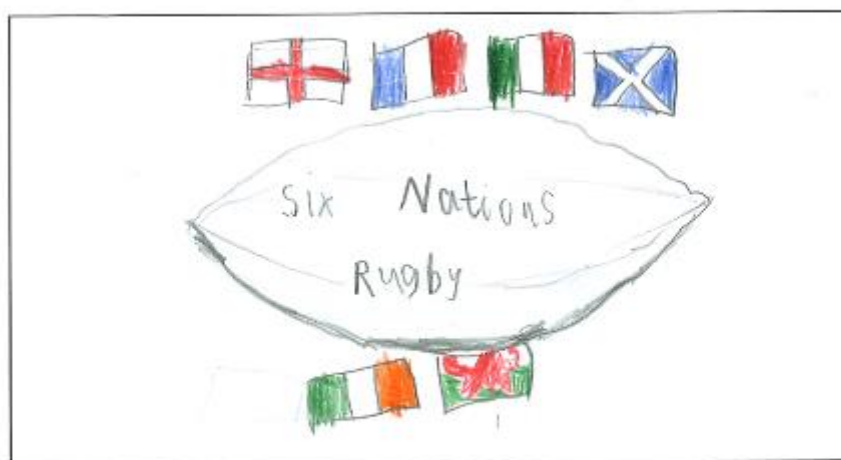


J. K. Rowling, an author who inspired

Super Six Nations! Who will be crowned the winner?

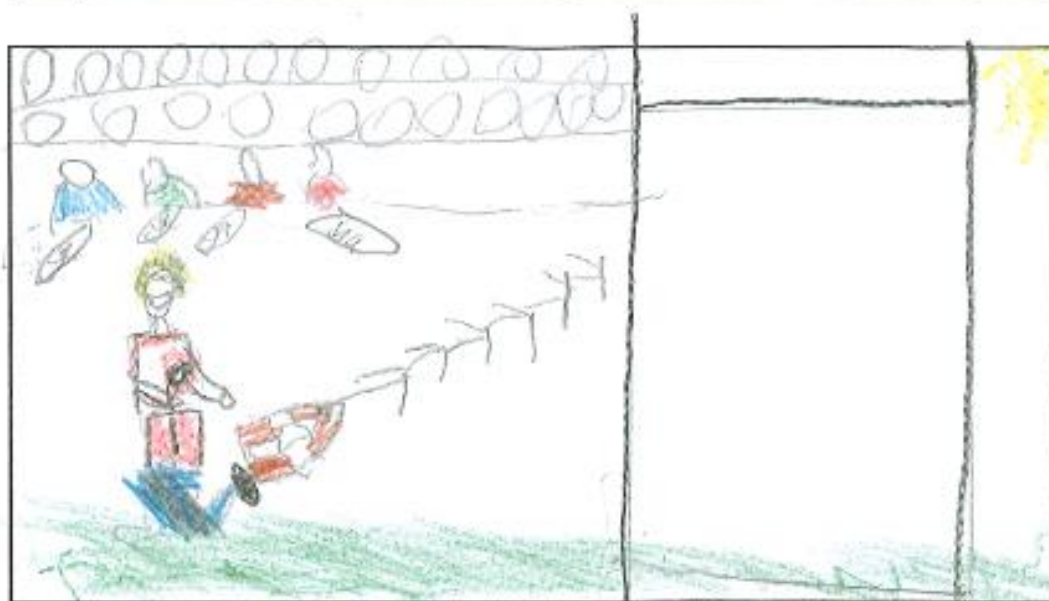

England have a very important match against Ireland on the 18th March. England must win this game. Good luck to all of the teams especially England.

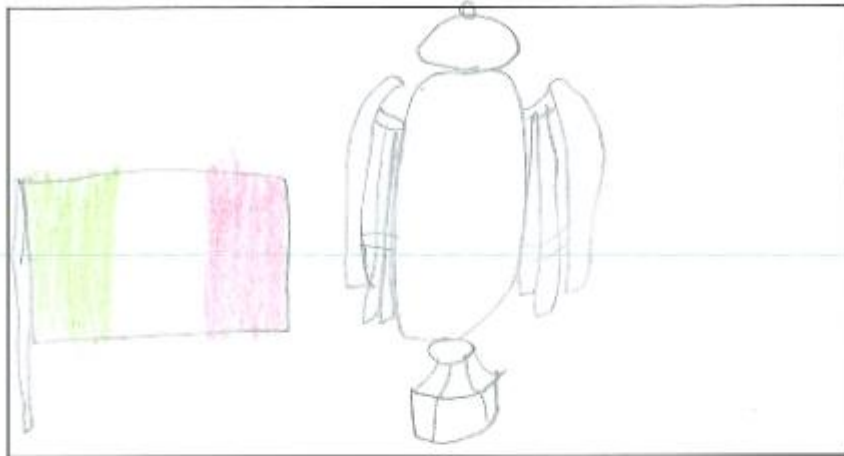

Six Nations began in 2000!

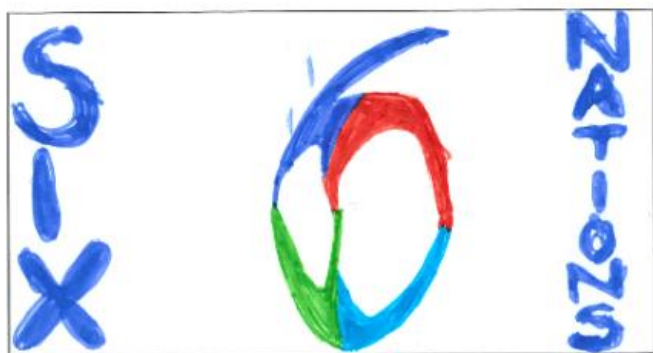
