During the coronation ceremony, King Charles III pronounced "I come not to be served, but to serve," in his first remarks. The 74-year

old king was rubbed with holy oil and dressed with an imperial mantle, while

the Archbishop of Canterbury placed the ancient crown of St Edward upon his head. Despite the rain, tens of thousands of people gathered in central London to see the King and Queen as they made their way from

Buckingham Palace to Westminster Abbey in the Diamond Jubilee State Coach. Here are some key

The ceremony included 19 military bands and 400 troops. The king and his family made an appearance on the balcony

(1) The balcony appearance of a display of aircraft including fighter jets and helicopters, which traditionally marks the grand finale of a royal celebration.

During the service, Charles III swore to support the Church of England. There were about 2,300 people attending the ceremony including all his family, world leaders, pop music stars and others. After years of family tensions, Prince Harry attended his father's coronation alone. We look forward to a new era, after an incredible 70 years of Queen Elizabeth's reign.
