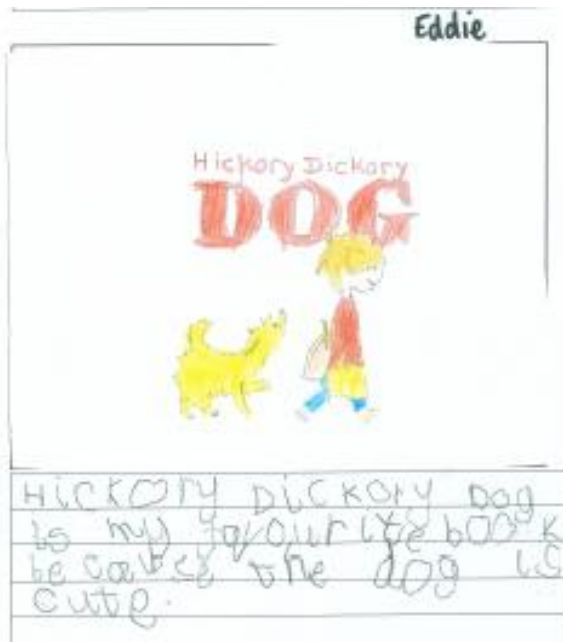

super woman.

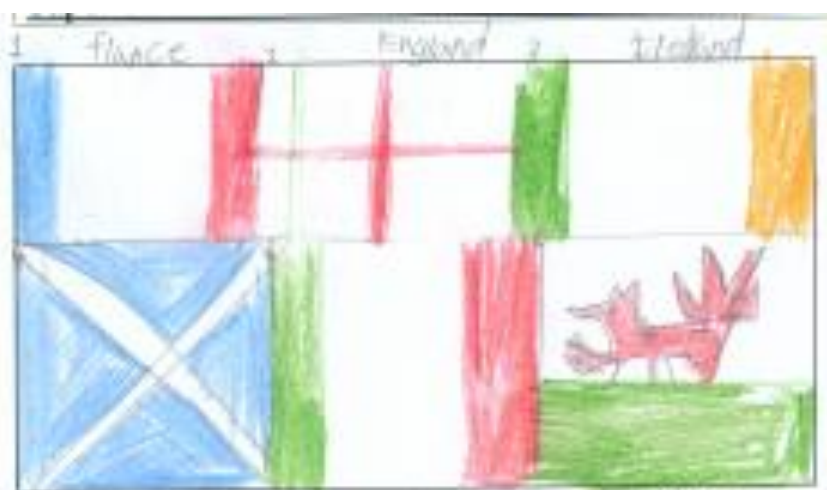

Super Six Nations- who will be crowned the winner?

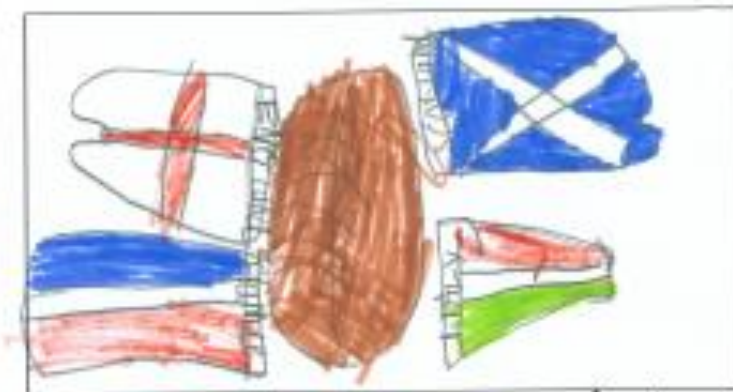


Scotland Italy Wales Oliver

COME ON ENGLAND.



The Six Nations is the oldest International Rugby tournament in the world. The six Nations are: England, Scotland, Ireland, Wales, France and Italy. They compete for the six Nations trophy. It began in 1882 and was called the Home Nations, with 4 teams: England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales. France joined

in 1910 and Italy in 2000. The teams get awarded 4 points if they win and 2 points if they draw.

- ① **try** When the ball is placed over the try line, scores 5 points.
- ② **conversion** After a try a team can win an extra two points by kicking between the posts.
- ③ **scrum** After a foul, players crouch and push against each other to win possession. I think Ireland will win this year's competition!

The Six Nations is a international rugby competition. The teams playing are England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales, France and Italy.

Since 1887, Wales won more competitions.

The Six Nations championship is held every year, first one being held 130 years ago. At the beginning only England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales played in a competition called

Home. Later national championships. In 1910, France joined and the competition was called five nations and in 2000, Italy came along and together became the Six Nations.

France is leading the standing, while England (2nd) and Ireland (3rd) are still in the title race.
