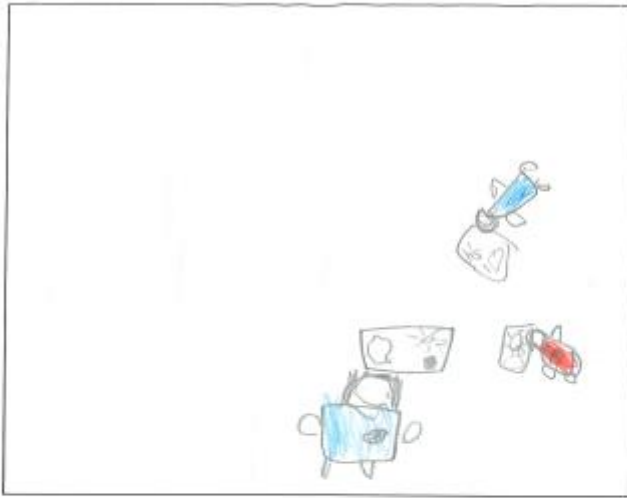

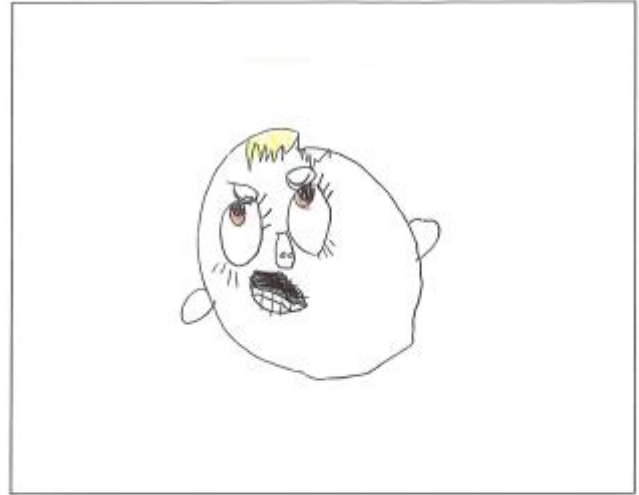

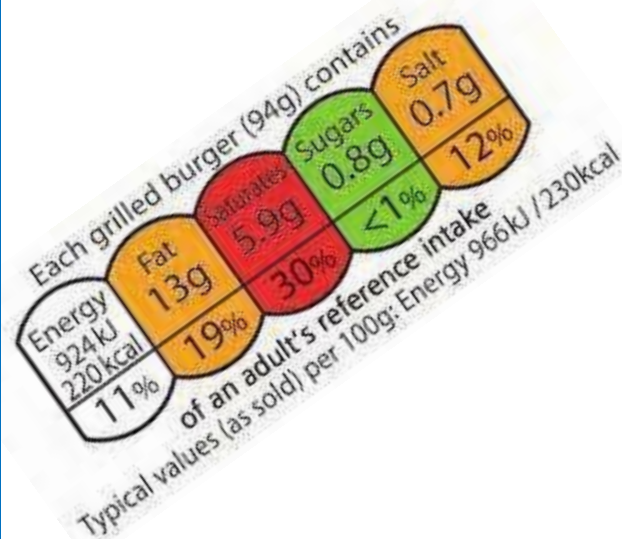

So who do you think is going to win this time? Any guesses?

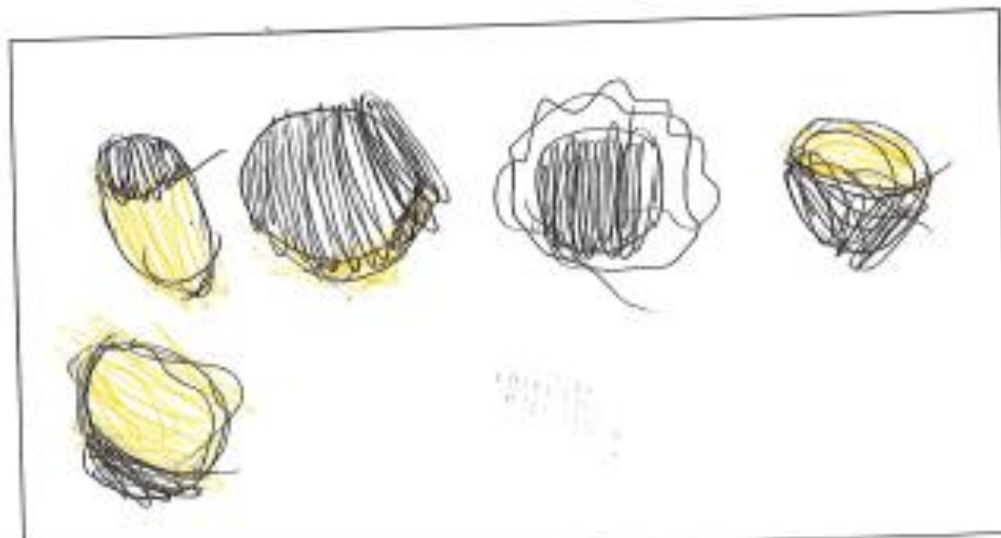


The Euros 2020 Championships

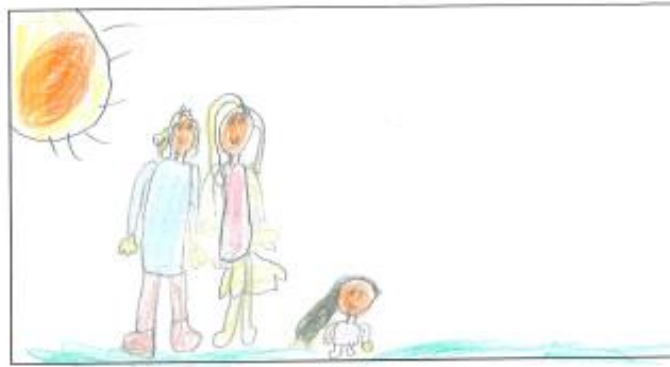


ROYAL BABY!

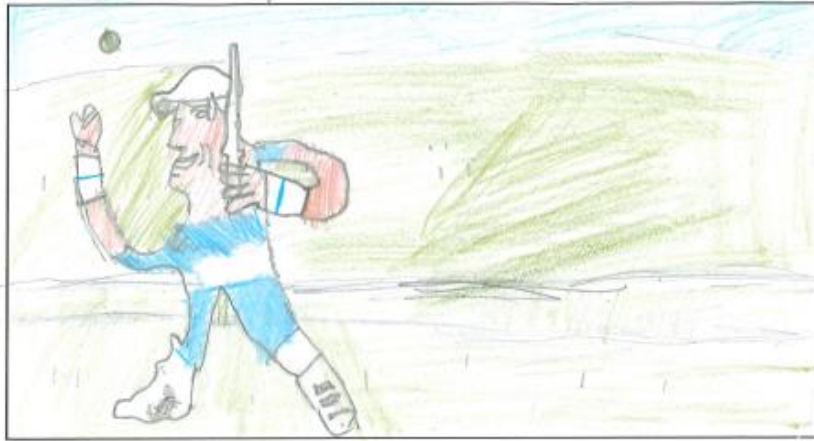
